What is bullying?

When someone or a group of people are intentionally doing any of the following things constantly not just once:

- Name calling or saying unkind comments
- Hurting physically
- Being unkind over the phone or internet



DON'T

- Copy the behaviour of the bully
- Do it back to them
- Join in with the bullying behaviour
- Keep it to yourself

- Tell a teacher, trusted adult or friend
