Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Leavers' Visit to Lake 32 Outdoor Centre

As an end of year treat, we are planning a visit to Lake 32 Outdoor Centre near Cirencester. This trip will take place on **Monday 6th July 2026**. On the day of the trip, we will depart via coach at **9.15am** and will arrive back at school for the end of the school day at **3.15pm**.

The children will be split into three groups and will take part in archery, raft-building and paddle boarding. The Centre will provide the children with a buoyancy aid and a qualified instructor from the centre will lead each activity with a member of Bridlewood staff supporting.

The children will need to bring with them a rucksack with the following items:

- Water shoes or old trainers (lake activities cannot be done in bare feet).
- A towel
- A dry set of clothes/trainers/flipflops to wear home
- Additional sun cream
- Water bottle
- Packed lunch
- Sun hat / cap
- A plastic bag for wet clothes

They should wear an old pair of shorts and t-shirt to enter the lake with a swimming costume underneath. 'Once-a-day' sun cream should be applied in the morning. In the event of colder weather, the centre will provide wet-suits. If your child is entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided by the school. If you would like this option, please email the school office with your child's choice of sandwich (ham, cheese or tuna) by Tuesday 30th June. In the case of financial hardship, please see Mrs Sammon. The children will not need spending money.

We are fortunate that this trip has been subsidised by the School Sports Premium as it is providing our year 6 children with an experience of exciting sports / physical activities they may not have tried before. We only ask for a voluntary contribution of **£12.50** per child to cover the cost of the trip. Unfortunately, the trip will be cancelled if we do not receive enough contributions, through ParentPay, to cover the cost of the visit by **Monday 15th June 2026**.
