Governor Vacancies to Local Governing Committee

Bridlewood Primary School

I am writing to inform you that there are currently vacancies on the Local Governing Committee (LGC) of **Bridlewood Primary School** and we would like to invite parents, carers or foster-parents who would be interested to put their names forward.

Parent LGC Members are elected by and from the parents, carers and foster parents of registered pupils at the school, for a 4-year term. Parent LGC Members share equally with other members of the Local Governing Committee the responsibility for carrying out their legal responsibilities delegated to them by the Trust. The position has always been an important one that is vital to the effective running of the school and is a means of giving worthwhile service to the community.

LGC Members bring a wide experience of the outside world, an independent view, a focus on development and improvement, accountability to the community for the use of resources and teaching and learning standards. In return, you gain the satisfaction of giving something back to the school community, a sense of purpose and achievement and new skills.

You will be expected to attend meetings of the Local Governing Committee which take place of a Monday evening at 6pm, at least 6 times a year. You will need to work as a member of the board (not as an individual) in the best interests of the school, show an interest in school activities, become well-informed about education and become familiar with the rules of governance. Training for the role is provided to keep governance knowledge up to date.

We ask that LGC Members are able to give the school their time (average of six hours a month), a willingness to learn, a listening ear and enquiring mind, the ability to assimilate information, make judgements and decisions and the ability to work as part of a team. A testimonial from a current parent LGC Member of the trust has been included at the base of this letter.

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If you wish to stand for election as a Parent LGC Member, it is necessary to be proposed by a parent, guardian or foster carer of a pupil registered at the school and to be seconded by another parent, carer or foster carer of a pupil registered at the school. The proposer and seconder should indicate their support for you by signing the enclosed nomination form. All nominations should be returned to via email by **Friday 7th November 2025.**

Please also include some detail about yourself (*Expression of Interest - Form 3 below*) including why you would like to become a LGC Member (no more than two hundred words) to support your nomination. This will be used if there is a need for an election by secret ballot. This will only take place if there are more nominations than there are vacancies.

There are some circumstances that disqualify an individual from serving on the governance team and these are listed below in the disqualification section. Please ensure that you read and sign.

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**FORM 1 - Disqualifications from serving as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member as per
The Park Academies Trust Articles of Association**

68. No person shall be qualified to be a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member unless he is aged 18 or over at the date of his election or appointment. No current pupil of any of the Academies shall be a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member.
69. A Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member shall cease to hold office if he becomes incapable by reason of illness or injury of managing or administering his own affairs.
70. A Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member shall cease to hold office if he is absent without the permission of the Trustee/Local Governing Committee Members from all their meetings held within a period of six months and the Trustee/Local Governing Committee Members resolve that his office be vacated.
71. A person shall be disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member if -
 - a. he has been declared bankrupt and/or his estate has been seized from his possession for the benefit of his creditors and the declaration or seizure has not been discharged, annulled or reduced; or
 - b. he is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or an interim order.
72. A person shall be disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member at any time when he is subject to a disqualification order or a disqualification undertaking under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 or to an order made under section 429(2)(b) of the Insolvency Act 1986 (failure to pay under county court administration order).
73. A Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member shall cease to hold office if he ceases to be a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member by virtue of any provision in the Companies Act 2006, is disqualified from acting as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member by virtue of section 178 of the Charities Act 2011 (or any statutory re-enactment or modification of that provision) or is otherwise found to be unsuitable by the Secretary of State under the provisions of the Relevant Funding Agreements.
74. A person shall be disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member if he has been removed from the office of charity Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member or Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member for a charity by an order made by the Charity Commission or the High Court on the grounds of any misconduct or mismanagement in the



administration of the charity for which he was responsible or to which he was privy, or which he by his conduct contributed to or facilitated.

75. Not used.

76. Not used.

77. A person shall be disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member where he has, at any time, been convicted of any criminal offence, excluding any that have been spent under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 as amended, and excluding any offence for which the maximum sentence is a fine or a lesser sentence except where a person has been convicted of any offence which falls under section 178 of the Charities Act 2011.
78. After the first Academy has opened, a person shall be disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member if he has not provided to the chairman of the Trustee/Local Governing Committee Members by the date of the Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member's appointment or as soon as practicable thereafter, a disclosure and barring service certificate (previously known as a criminal records certificate) at an enhanced disclosure level under section 113B of the Police Act 1997. In the event that the certificate discloses any information which would in the opinion of either the chairman or the Chief Executive Officer confirm their unsuitability to work with children that person shall be disqualified. If a dispute arises as to whether a person shall be disqualified, a referral shall be made to the Secretary of State to determine the matter. The determination of the Secretary of State shall be final.
79. Where, by virtue of these Articles a person becomes disqualified from holding, or continuing to hold office as a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member; and he is, or is proposed, to become such a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member, he shall upon becoming so disqualified give written notice of that fact to the Clerk.
80. Articles 68 to 74, Articles 77 to 79 and Articles 97 to 98 also apply to any member of any committee of the Trustee/Local Governing Committee Members, including a Local Governing Committee, or to any person whom the Trustee/Local Governing Committee Members shall have delegated functions or powers, in each case who is not a Trustee/Local Governing Committee Member.

I have noted the disqualifications, none of which apply to me.
