Dear Parents/Carers

Due to the rise in temperatures again next week, we have had to amend our Sports Day to avoid the hottest part of the day.

Sports day is still scheduled to take place on **Tuesday 7th July 2026**. However, the timings and activities have changed slightly to allow us to avoid being out in the hottest part of the day:

The timetable for the day will now be as follows:

9:00-10:30 – Sports day for Nursery, Reception and KS1 (**Hedgehogs, Cherry, Pine and Ash**)

10:30-12:00 – Sports day for KS2 (**Elm, Birch, Maple and Oak**)

12:00-12:30 – Picnic lunch on the field

After the first sessions, parents/carers are welcome to stay and watch KS2 or leave and come back for the picnic lunch. Early Years and KS1 children will go back to their classrooms until lunchtime.

The Early Years and KS1 activities will consist of a carousel of events. KS2 will have a mixture of a carousel of events and sprint races if time allows.

You are invited to bring a picnic lunch to share with your children on the field at lunch time. If you are unable to attend sports day your nursery child will eat their lunch as a picnic in the nursery garden with members of staff supervising.

If your child does not normally attend a Tuesday morning session, you are welcome to bring them to sports day for them to take part in the activities and with the picnic lunch on the field. Any child attending who does not normally attend a Tuesday morning session, will not be included in our nursery ratios and therefore the adult attending with them must supervise them at all times and remain on the field with them when we return to the nursery garden.

Your child should wear clothing which is appropriate for taking part in sporting activities. All children must wear trainers. Please ensure your child has a sun hat to wear and has had a long-lasting sun cream applied prior to coming to nursery.

We apologise for any inconvenience but have made adjustments to ensure the day can still go ahead.

Please let me know if you will be attending our sports day.
