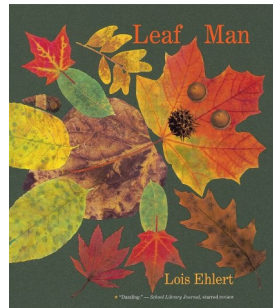
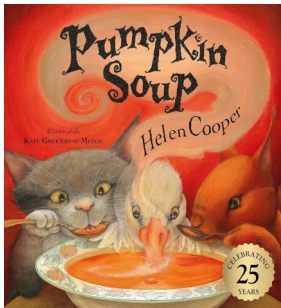
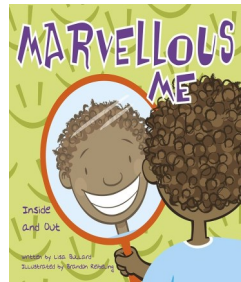
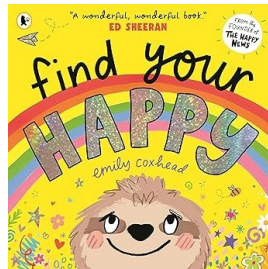
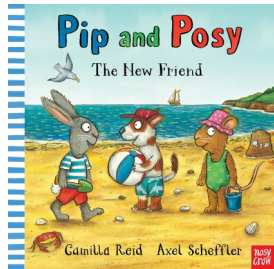


FS1—Knowledge Organiser: Autumn 1

Supporting learning and development at home

Talking Tips

- **Watch, wait, and listen first.** Your child may be playing an interesting and imaginative game that you can join in with.
- **Get down to your child's level.** This will give your child the chance to make eye contact with you and to watch your facial expressions.

Encouraging independence with wiping and pulling up trousers after using the toilet.

Encourage children to try putting on their coat

Zippering up own coat and turning sleeves which are inside out.

Senses Senses allow us to observe and understand the world around us.

Harvest Harvesting is the process of gathering ripe crops, or animals and fish, to eat.

Diwali The festival of Light, celebrated by the Hindu and Sikh religion.

Emotions An emotion is a feeling such as happiness, love, fear or anger, which can be caused by the situation that you are in or the people you are with.

Independent Learning Children being able to use the environment for themselves, to make choices and decisions and to develop their own thoughts and views.
