During your stay all specialist equipment will be supplied together with waterproof jacket and trousers, rucksack and wellies. Where needed, walking boots and fleeces will be provided.

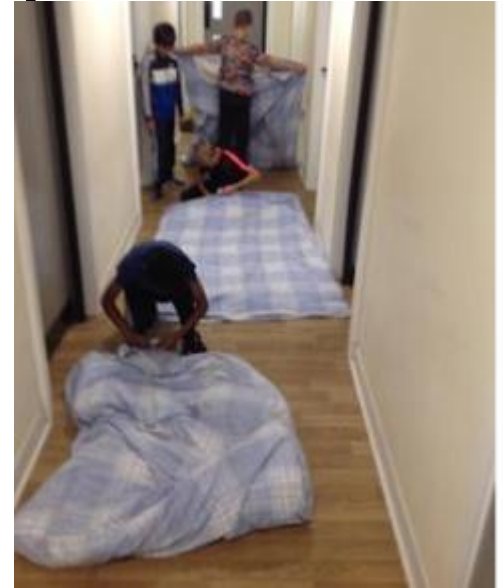
