Oxenwood Residential Visit 2026

- Three days, two nights
- Wednesday 24th – Friday 26th June
- Adults: Mrs Helsby and others to be confirmed
- Any remaining children to attend school, as usual
- Second meeting after Easter

Accommodation

- The centre can sleep up to 38 children (and 8 adults)
- **4 dormitory-style rooms** - one with 20 beds and three 6-bed rooms
- Staff bedrooms adjacent to dorms
- **Shared toilet and shower facilities**, including disabled access facilities
